

Diploma Supplement

This Diploma Supplement follows the model developed by the European Commission, the Council of Europe and UNESCO. The purpose of the supplement is to provide sufficient independent data to improve the international „transparency“ and fair academic and professional recognition of qualifications (diplomas, degrees, certificates etc.). It is designed to provide a description of the nature, level, context, content and status of the studies that were pursued and successfully completed by the individual named on the original qualification to which this supplement is appended. It is free from any value judgements, equivalence statements or suggestions about recognition. Information in all eight sections should be provided. Where information is not provided in one of the sections, an explanation should give the reason why.
