Railway services in Austria

- ÖBB (www.oebb.at/en) if you book online in advance, check for "SparSchiene", which offers cheap tickets.
- WESTBAHN (https://westbahn.at/en) this railway company only operates between the cities of Salzburg, Linz and Vienna.
 Book tickets online or buy them on the train or at licensed tobacco shops at the train stations. Check for discounts.

If you don't have an ÖBB discount card, it might be cheaper to purchase the tickets from "Westbahn". In any case, always compare prices.

ÖBB VORTEILSCARD

If you stay longer and would like to discover Austria by train, it is worth purchasing ÖBB Vorteilscard. Anyone under 26 years can get ÖBB "Vorteilscard Jugend". Currently, it costs 19 Euros and is valid for one year. It qualifies for a discount of up to 50% for all ÖBB train tickets. To buy the card you need to present your passport. You can request the card at any train station ticket counter or online at www.oebb.at/en

Medical care and insurance

Health and accident insurance

You are required to have valid health and accident insurance coverage during your studies in Austria. By paying the Federal Austrian Students' Union fee, you automatically obtain a liability and accident insurance for the time of your studies or traineeship in Austria.

SELF-INSURANCE from your home country

- European health insurance card for nationals of EU/EEA countries and Switzerland
- provisional substitute
- insurance policies of various insurance companies, etc.

STUDENT SELF-INSURANCE in Upper Austria

Getting things cheaper

Aktivpass

By registering your main residence in Linz, you can get the so-called "Aktivpass" of the city of Linz (see also "Getting in and around"). It qualifies you to receive many reductions for public transport, events, tickets and much more. Unfortunately, there are no equal offers in Steyr and Wels.

Requirements

- 18 years old
- low net income
- main residence in Linz (by registering at respective "Meldeamt")

Required documents

- proof of income
- photo
- study/student card
- passport

Shopping

In Austria shop opening hours may differ from those in your home country. In the cities shops are open Monday to Friday from 09:00 am – 06:00 pm. Opening hours on Saturdays are from 09:00 – 12:00 am, main shops are open till 05:00 pm.

Some shops close for lunch (12:00 am – 02:00 pm). Grocery shops often open before 08:00 am and close at 06:30 pm. In tourist centres many shops are also open on weekends.



Banks

Most banks here in Austria offer a student account which is free of charge. Please ask at the banks for detailed information about these student accounts. Usually banks are open from Monday to Friday between 08:30 am and 04:00 pm and often close for one or two hours during lunchtime. Some banks also close on Wednesday or Friday afternoons. Please check for opening hours.
